Most designer watches just sit there looking pretty. But there's more than a fetching face to new timepieces from **Chanel**, **Dior** and **Fendi**. A decade after its ceramic J12 debuted, Chanel outfits its most popular design in a dive suit. The **J12 Marine** is equipped with a rotating bezel for tracking dive times and a screw-in crown that keeps the watch watertight down to 300 meters. Beneath the sparkling dial of Dior's **Christal 8** beats the heart of an engineer, with a novel movement that shows the time in eight cities. And Fendi's new **Crazy Carats**, debuting in October, makes for an instant wardrobe change. By turning its second crown, a different set of gems rotates into view, so you can go from sapphires to diamonds as easily as changing your shoes. —*Laurie Kahle*
